Privacy Notice



1.- Responsible for the treatment.

2.- Services.

SPARK offers Telecommunications and related services (from now on, jointly called the "Services").

3.- Categories of personal data subject to processing.

For the provision of our Services and to comply with the processing purposes indicated in this Privacy Notice, it is necessary for SPARK to process the following:

a) Personal data.

SPARK will process the following classes of personal data:

- i. Identification data.
 - Full name.
 - Birthdate.
 - CURP.
 - RFC.
 - Social Security number.
 - Conventional address.
 - Tax residence.
- ii. Contact information.
 - Email.
 - Landline.
 - Cell phone.
- iii. Banking and/or asset details.
 - Bank account (optional).
- b) Sensitive data.

SPARK does not request Sensitive Personal Data at any time.

Through its website, SPARK uses cookies and other technologies through which it is possible to monitor the behavior of users on the Internet, as well as provide said users with a better service and experience when browsing said page. The only personal data SPARK obtains through these tracking technologies is the I.P. number so that when you enter the browser again, the I.P. is registered on the SPARK website, and you enter it more easily.

4.- Primary purposes of the treatment.

SPARK will process the personal data described in this Notice to carry out any or all of the activities necessary for the development and fulfillment of the obligations that originate and derive from the Services, which include the following purposes:

a) Identification.

SPARK may accredit and verify your identity following our procedures and policies.

b) Contact.

SPARK may contact you for business relationship and customer service purposes, as well as to provide notifications.

c) Registration.

SPARK generates databases with dissociated Personal Data for consultation by the personnel who process your Personal Data.

d) Preparation of a Service Provision and/or labor contract.

5.- Secondary purposes of the treatment.

SPARK will process your personal data to carry out any or all of the secondary purposes mentioned below:

a) Marketing and Advertising.

7.- Transfers.

a) Not subject to consent.

SPARK may transfer your data to both national and foreign entities without requiring your consent in the following cases:

- When the transfer is necessary or legally required to safeguard public interest or procure or administer justice.
- b) Subject to consent.

To provide you with a better service, SPARK may transfer to third parties, who will offer you similar or complementary services to those that SPARK offers. For the above, you must provide your consent.

These transfers are aligned with this Privacy Notice, so the Third Parties will treat your Personal Data as if we treated them.

You accept that SPARK carries out Transfers of your Personal Data to provide better service and experience.

8.- Means and approach to exercise ARCO Rights and/or revocation of consent for the processing of personal data.

You or your legal representative may exercise any of the rights of access, rectification, cancellation, or opposition (from now on, "ARCO Rights"), as well as revoke your consent for the processing of your data by sending an email to the Personal Data Department from SPARK to the email address <u>datospersonales@sparktelecomm.com</u> where you will be attended to on time.

Your proposition must be made through the Form for Exercising ARCO Rights, Revocation of Consent and/or Limitation of the Use or Disclosure of Personal Data (from now on the "Form"), which must be sent to the email address datospersonales@sparktelecomm.com, said Form will be available on the SPARK Website or can be obtained by email sent to the above email address.

For the SPARK Personal Data Department to follow up on your request, you or your legal representative must correctly prove your identity, for which it is necessary that you complete all the fields indicated in the Form and accompany it with a copy of one of your valid official identifications.

These identification documents contain:

- Voter credential (INE)
- Digitalized professional license
- Passport
- FM2, FM3 (Immigration document)
- Driving license type A, B, or C. (Issued in the Mexican Republic, not accept foreign licenses)

Further, and if it is done through a legal representative, one of the following documents will have to be included to prove the representation:

- Public deed of power.
- Power of attorney signed before two witnesses.

If the information supplied in the Form is incorrect or insufficient, or the corresponding accreditation documents are not accompanied, the SPARK Personal Data Department, within five (5) business days following receipt of the application, may require you to provide the necessary elements or documents to process it. You will have ten (10) business days to respond to the request, counting from the day after you receive it. If a response is not provided within said period, the corresponding request will be considered not submitted.

The SPARK Personal Data Department will notify you of the determination embraced within a total period of twenty (20) business days from the date on which the request was received so that, if appropriate, it can be made effective within fifteen (15) business days following the response being communicated. If the request is not accepted, the Owner will be notified. The positive or negative response will be given electronically to the email address specified in the Form at no cost to the Owner.

9.- SPARK Personal Data Department.

It is essential to notify you that SPARK has a Personal Data Department, which, as part of its operations, is liable for resolving any questions related to using your information. Correspondingly, the Personal Data Department will follow up on any complaint or claim that you may have related to the processing of your data.
